

Summary of Service:

115th (Flintshire) Battalion - 4th August 1914 based at the Drill Hall, Flint as part of North Wales Brigade, Welsh Division. To Conway till end of August 1914, then to Northampton. December 1914 to Cambridge. May 1915 to Bedford. 13th May 1915 formation became 158th Brigade, 53rd (Welsh) Division. 19th July 1915 sailed from Devonport for Imbros. 9th August 1915 landed at Suvla Bay, Gallipoli. December 1915 to Egypt. 3rd August 1918 amalgamated with 116th to form 516th Battalion. 31st October 1918 158th Brigade, 53rd (Welsh) Division moving back from Palestine to Egypt.

215th (Flintshire) Battalion - A second line battalion formed at Wrexham September 1914. April 1915 to 203rd Brigade, 68th Division at Northampton. July 1915 Bedford. November 1916 Westleton, Suffolk. May 1917 to Henham Park, Halesworth, Suffolk. October 1917 to Yarmouth and disbanded on 16th March 1918.

315th (Flintshire) Battalion - A third line battalion formed in March 1915 at Flint. 8th April 1916 re-designated Reserve Battalions. 1st September 1916 Absorbed in 4th (Reserve) Battalion at Oswestry, Shropshire. March 1918 to Kinmel, North Wales. July 1918 to Herne Bay, Sussex to end of war.

116th (Carnarvonshire and Anglesey) Battalion - 4th August 1914 Barracks at Carnarvon as part of North Wales Brigade, Welsh Division. To Conway till end of August 1914, then to Northampton. December 1914 to Cambridge. May 1915 to Bedford. 13th May 1915 formation became 158th Brigade, 53rd (Welsh) Division. 19th July 1915 sailed from Devonport for Imbros. 9th August 1915 landed at Suvla Bay, Gallipoli. December 1915 to Egypt. 3rd August 1918 amalgamated with 115th to form 516th Battalion. 31st October 1918 158th Brigade, 53rd (Welsh) Division moving back from Palestine to Egypt.

216th (Carnarvonshire and Anglesey) Battalion - A second line battalion formed at Carmarthen September 1914. April 1915 to 203rd Brigade, 68th Division at Northampton. July 1915 Bedford. November 1916 to Southwold, Suffolk. April 1917 to Henham Park, Halesworth, Suffolk. Disbanded 8th September 1917.

316th (Carnarvonshire and Anglesey) Battalion - A third line battalion formed in May 1915 at Carnarvon. 8th April 1916 re-designated Reserve Battalions. 1st September 1916 absorbed into 4th (Reserve) Battalion at Oswestry, Shropshire. March 1918 to Kinmel, North Wales. July 1918 to Herne Bay, Sussex to end of war.

117th (Merioneth and Montgomery) Battalion - 4th August 1914 Newtown, Montgomery as part of North Wales Brigade, Welsh Division. To Conway till end of August 1914, then to Northampton. December 1914 to Cambridge. May 1915 to Bedford. 13th May 1915 formation became 158th Brigade, 53rd (Welsh) Division. 19th July 1915 sailed from Devonport for Imbros. 9th August 1915 landed at Suvla Bay, Gallipoli. December 1915 to Egypt. 24th June 1918 160th Brigade, 53rd (Welsh) Division. 31st October 1918 160th Brigade, 53rd (Welsh) Division moving back from Palestine to Egypt.

217th (Merioneth and Montgomery) Battalion - A second line battalion formed at Newtown September 1914. Subsequent record same as 216th Battalion but at Wrentham, Suffolk for winter 1916-1917. November 1916 absorbed 211st Brecknockshire Battalion, South Wales Borderers. Disbanded 12th September 1917.

317th (Merioneth and Montgomery) Battalion - A third line battalion formed in June 1915 at Newtown. 8th April 1916 re-designated a Reserve Battalion. 1st September 1916 absorbed into 4th (Reserve) Battalion at Oswestry, Shropshire. March 1918 to Kinmel, North Wales. July 1918 to Herne Bay, Sussex to end of war.
