**Summary of Service:**

**11st Montgomeryshire Yeomanry:** 4th August 1914 Mobilised at Welshpool as part of South Wales Mounted Brigade. 12th August 1914 South Wales Mounted Brigade to Hereford. 29th August 1914 to Thetford, Norfolk then to Blickling, Norfolk where Brigade joins 1st Mounted Division. September 1915 to Holt, Norfolk. October 1915 to Cromer, Norfolk. 4th March 1916 Sailed from Devonport for Egypt. 20th March 1916 Brigade with Welsh Mounted Brigade formed 4th Dismounted Brigade part of the Egyptian Western Frontier Force.

**11st Welsh Horse Yeomanry:** Formed in August 1914 in South Wales under administration of the Glamorgan TF Association with HQ in Cardiff. Later in 1914 administration transferred to Montgomeryshire TF Association with HQ at Newtown. Early 1915 became part of 1st North Midland Mounted Brigade, 1st Mounted Division based at Diss area in Norfolk. Feb 1915 transferred to 1st Eastern Mounted Brigade, 1st Mounted Division in Woodbridge area in Suffolk. 25th September 1915 sailed (dismounted) aboard RMS Olympic from Liverpool. 10th October 1915 Landed at ANZAC beach, Gallipoli attached to 54th Division. December 1915 to Egypt. 22nd February 1916 Eastern and South Eastern Mounted Brigades form 3rd Dismounted Brigade as part Suez Canal defence forces. July 1916 to the Egyptian Western Frontier Force.

**25th (Montgomeryshire and Welsh Horse Yeomanry) Battalion The Royal Welsh Fusiliers:** Battalion formed at Helmia, Egypt on 4th March 1917 from dismounted Montgomery Yeomanry and Welsh Horse Yeomanry in 231st Brigade 74th Division. Early May 1918 to France. 11th November 1918 part of 231st Brigade 74th Division at north of Ath, Belgium.
