10 October 1940	St Mary's Hall, Fishguard, Pembrokeshire, 224 Brigade.
24 February 1941	Kirk Lavington Hall, Yarm, Yorkshire
20 May 1941	Castle Eden, Co Durham
5 August 1941	Mount House, Castle Eden, Co Durham
15 November 1941	Re-designated as 90th LAA Regiment Royal Artillery (Btys 311, 312 & 313) which subsequently served in North Africa and Italy.
27 November 1941	Carlisle; Battalion deleted from Infantry Order of Battle.
