1 June 1939	Created from 2nd Battalion Monmouthshire Regiment TA.
13 August 1939	Battalion mobilised as part of 38th Welsh Division. at Dan-y-Graig, Porthcawl, South Wales. Task to guard key points Oil Works, Llandovery; Cardiff Airport; Ordnance Factory, Bridgend.
4 August 1940	Rugeley, Staffordshire
September 1940	Ingestre Park, Rugeley, Staffordshire
10 October 1940	Pettypool Park, Sandiway, Northwich, Cheshire
4 November 1940	Ordenarde Barracks, Marlborough Lines, Aldershot
6 March 1941	Camberley, Surrey
16 April 1941	Nutfield, Uckfield, Sussex
4 July 1941	Brighton, Sussex
29 November 1941	Corfe Castle, Wareham, Dorset
2 December 1941	Swanage and Kingstone, Dorset
27/28 February 1942	AA Platoon took part in raid at Bruneval on the French Coast
25 May 1942	Poole, Dorset
14 August 1942	Steepleton Iwerne Camp, Blandford, Dorset
8 October 1942	Merley Park Camp, Wimbourne, Dorset.
12 December 1942	Battalion absorbed into 1st Battalion The South Wales Borderers.
