Summary of Service:

1/4th (Carmarthenshire) Battalion TF: 4th August 1914: Carmarthen part of South Wales Infantry Brigade. November 1914: Tunbridge Wells, Kent. February 1915: to Scotland on Forth and Tay Defences. 17th April 1915: Bedford in 159th Brigade part of 53rd (Welsh) Division. 19th July 1915: sailed from Devonport for Mudros, arrived 5th August 1915. 9th August 1915: landed at Suvla Bay. 8th October 1915: amalgamated with 1/5th Battalion to form 4th Welsh Composite Battalion. 11th December 1915: left Gallipoli for Egypt. 20th February 1916: resumed identity. 30th July 1918: 1/4th and 1/5th Battalions formed 4/5th Battalion. 31st October 1918: Palestine in 159th Brigade part of 53rd (Welsh) Division. 53rd Division was moving back from Palestine to Egypt.

2/4th Battalion TF: A Second Line Battalion formed at Carmarthen in October 1914. November 1915: at Bedford, absorbed by 2/4th KSLI at Bedford.

3/4th Battalions TF: A Third Line Battalion formed at Carmarthen in March 1915. 8th April 1916: To Milford Haven – became a Reserve Battalion. 1st September 1916: 4th (Reserve) Battalion absorbed 5th and 6th Reserve Battalions at Milford Haven, Pembrokeshire where it remained as part of Milford Haven Garrison.

1/5th Battalion TF: 4th August 1914: Pontypridd part of South Wales Infantry Brigade. November 1914: Tunbridge Wells, Kent. February 1915: to Scotland on Forth and Tay Defences. 17th April 1915: Bedford in 159th Brigade part of 53rd (Welsh) Division. 19th July 1915: sailed from Devonport for Mudros, arrived 5th August 1915. 9th August 1915: landed at Suvla Bay. 8th October 1915: amalgamated with 1/4th Battalion to form 4th Welsh Composite Battalion. 11th December 1915: left Gallipoli for Egypt. 20th February 1916: resumed identity. 30th July 1918 1/4th and 1/5th Battalions formed 4/5th Battalion. 31st October 1918: Palestine in 159th Brigade part of 53rd (Welsh) Division. 53rd Division was moving back from Palestine to Egypt.

2/5th Battalion TF: A Second Line Battalion formed at Pontypridd in November 1914. November 1915: at Bedford, absorbed by 2/6th Cheshire Regiment.

3/5th Battalion TF: A Third Line Battalion formed at Pontypridd in March 1915. 8th April 1916: To Milford Haven – became a Reserve Battalion. 1st September 1916: 4th (Reserve) Battalion absorbed 5th and 6th Reserve Battalions at Milford Haven, Pembrokeshire where it remained as part of Milford Haven Garrison.
