Summary of Service:

1/6th (Glamorgan) Battalion TF: 4th August 1914: Swansea part of South Wales Infantry Brigade. 29th October 1914: landed at Le Havre, France; to guard Lines of Communication. 5th July 1915: Posted to 84th Brigade part of 28th Division. 23rd October 1915: Posted to 3rd Brigade part of 1st Division. 15th May 1916 became Pioneer Battalion to 1st Division. 11th November 1918: La Vallee Mulatre, North East of Bohain, France as Pioneer Battalion to 1st Division.

2/6th (Glamorgan) Battalion TF: A Second Line Battalion formed at Swansea in December 1914. November 1915: at Bedford, absorbed by 2/5th Royal Welsh Fusiliers.

3/6th (Glamorgan) Battalion TF: A Third Line Battalion formed at Swansea in about March 1915. 8th April 1916: To Milford Haven – became a Reserve Battalion. 1st September 1916: 4th (Reserve) Battalion absorbed 5th and 6th Reserve Battalions at Milford Haven, Pembrokeshire where it remained as part of Milford Haven Garrison.
