Summary of Service:

111st Pembroke Yeomanry: 4th August 1914 Mobilised at Tenby as part of the South Wales Mounted Brigade. 12th August 1914 Brigade concentrated at Hereford. End of August 1914 to Thetford area, Norfolk as part of 1st Mounted Division, then to Aylsham area with regiment at Hindolveston and Heydon, Norfolk. October 1915 to Cromer area. November 1915 Unit became dismounted. March 1916 Sailed for Egypt. 20th March 1916 South Wales Mounted Brigade became 4th Dismounted Brigade.

111st Glamorgan Yeomanry: 4th August 1914 Mobilised at Bridgend as part of the South Wales Mounted Brigade. 12th August 1914 Brigade concentrated at Hereford. End of August 1914 to Thetford area, Norfolk as part of 1st Mounted Division, then to Aylsham area. October 1915 to Cromer area. November 1915 Unit became dismounted. March 1916 Sailed for Egypt. 20th March 1916 South Wales Mounted Brigade became 4th Dismounted Brigade.

24th (Pembroke and Glamorgan Yeomanry) Battalion The Welsh Regiment: 2nd February 1917: Battalion formed in Egypt from two dismounted yeomanry regiments - Pembroke and Glamorgan - previously in 4th Dismounted Brigade. Posted to 231st Brigade part of 74th Division. May 1918: to France, landing at Marseilles 7 May. 11th November 1918: Ath, Belgium in 231st Brigade part of 74th Division.
